CLASSIC 'CINDERELLA' TO BE PERFORMED BY RENO STUDENTS

More than 50 artists, dancers, singers and actors will come together to perform "Cinderella" today through Sunday and Sept. 11 to 13.

The Disney classic, which will be performed at 7:30 p.m. at the Robert Z. Hawkins Outdoor Amphitheater at Bartley Ranch, will feature students at the Sierra School of Performing Arts.

Although many of the cast are children and young adults, Reno vocalist Cami Thompson will perform a leading role as the Fairy Godmother. The Broadway adaptation's no-
